1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:40 pm.

2. Roll Call

A: Novel Coronavirus COVID-19 and the Library

Ms. Aldrich reported that we are in a good spot with opening back up. Michigan has lifted all restrictions while MIOSHA has lifted all with the exception of healthcare settings. We are waiting for guidance on what to do and will be watching the vaccination numbers for now.

10. New Business

A: Fence

It was discovered that the Imlay City library owns the picket fence that is located on the north side of the parking lot. A couple of sections have come loose. Volunteers from Gateway Church have offered to fix it. Once that part is completed, it will be stained.

B: Arbor Vitae

The board received two proposals regarding the Arbor Vitae on the north side of the Imlay City library that need attention. There is new growth trying to come through on the dying areas. They agreed to have Owen Tree Service, Inc. perform a deep root fertilizer treatment on the affected areas at a cost of \$300.00.

C: Drinking Fountain

The board received an overview regarding the recommendation to switch the Imlay City library drinking fountain to a bottle filling station for improved hygiene and safety. Ms. Aldrich will do further research on available models and bring that back to the board.

D: Sesquicentennial Parade

Library staff will be participating in the Imlay City Sesquicentennial Celebration Parade on August 14, 2021. Participants will be marching with a giant book while passing out candy and library card themed bookmarks.

11. Communications

Communications included a newspaper article recognizing Cynthia Stroebel as Imlay City 'Citizen of the Year' and the Summer 2021 newsletter.
